You MUST submit your appeal to the assigned Divisional rep. for the division you compete in by 7pm the Friday after your event. You also must submit the \$100 appeal fee to the frrc venmo account of: @foxriverracingclub If you do not have a venmo account, you may deliver the \$100 in cash to one of the 4 officers, by 7pm the Friday following the club event.

Appeals can only be for YOU, not something that happened to one of your competitors.

Regardless of the final decision, a record will be kept of your disagreement and your appeal.

If the BOD overturns the FRRC Race Director's decision, you will receive your \$100 back. If you lose the appeal with the BOD, the \$100 will go into the general FRRC funds.

**IMPORTANT: On track calls made by the flagman, race director or scorers on race night are considered final, as well as suspensions and fines from officers. Those decisions are not appealable.**
